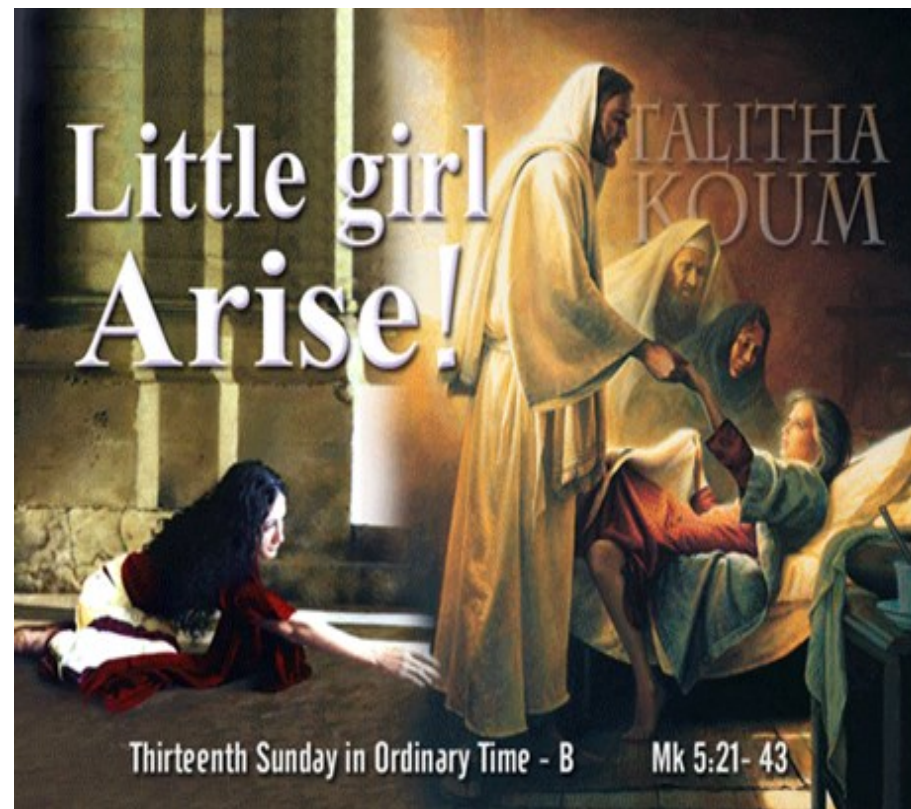

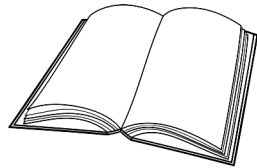

GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULATION (GDPR)

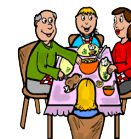
