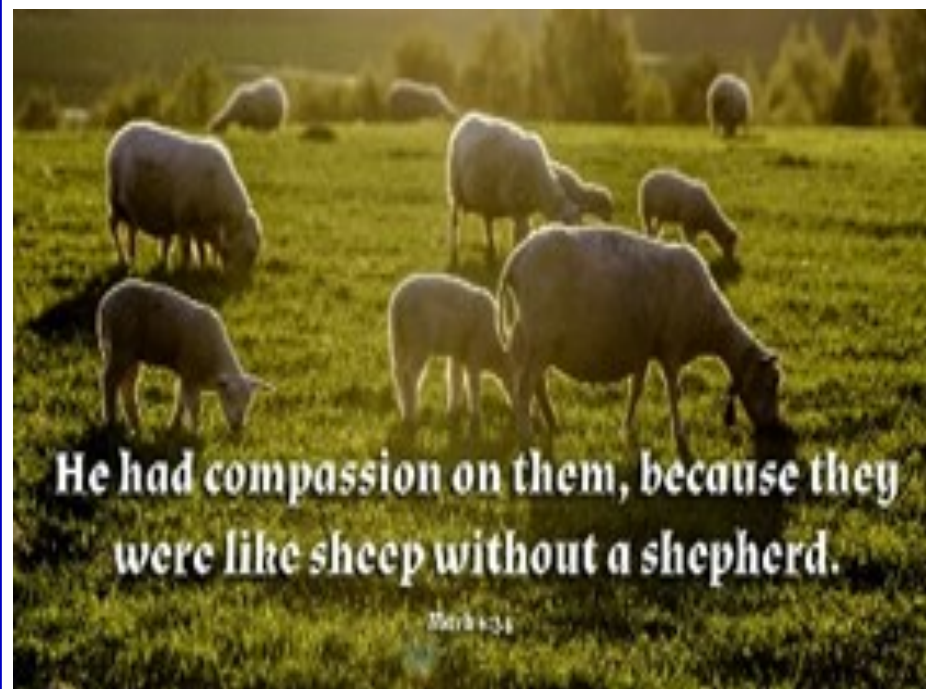

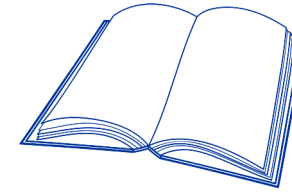
GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULATION (GDPR)

The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he has anointed me to bring good news to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim release to the captives and recovery of sight to the blind, to let the oppressed go free, to proclaim the year of the Lord's favor.

JOHNSON SEQUEIRA

Born in Mumbai, India, Johnson was brought up in the Catholic faith, but had no relationship with the Lord, until, following the loss of his business, he went into a deep depression at the age of 33. During this time he even forgot his own name! However, when he attended 9 Holy Mass & received Communion, celebrated by Father Jose, our Lord set Johnson free. He was anointed by the Holy Spirit and immediately dedicated his life to our Lord Jesus Christ.

He is an active member in the Catholic Charismatic Renewal of the Archdiocese of Bangalore and has been travelling to Sri Lanka, Kuwait, UAE, Oman, Uganda and Australia along with many places around India, proclaiming the Good News. His preaching is accompanied by healing, signs and wonders. He organises and is responsible for the rehabilitation of men addicted to alcohol and drugs in Goa, India and he has also established rehabilitation centres for women in Sri Lanka. These rehabilitation centres are funded by Divine Providence, with no cost incurred by any of the participants - Matthew 10:8.

Johnson also helps poor farmers in Uganda by preaching the Gospel and delivering many from demonic possession. All his teachings are available @ jclm.info through his Jesus Christ Is Lord Ministries.
