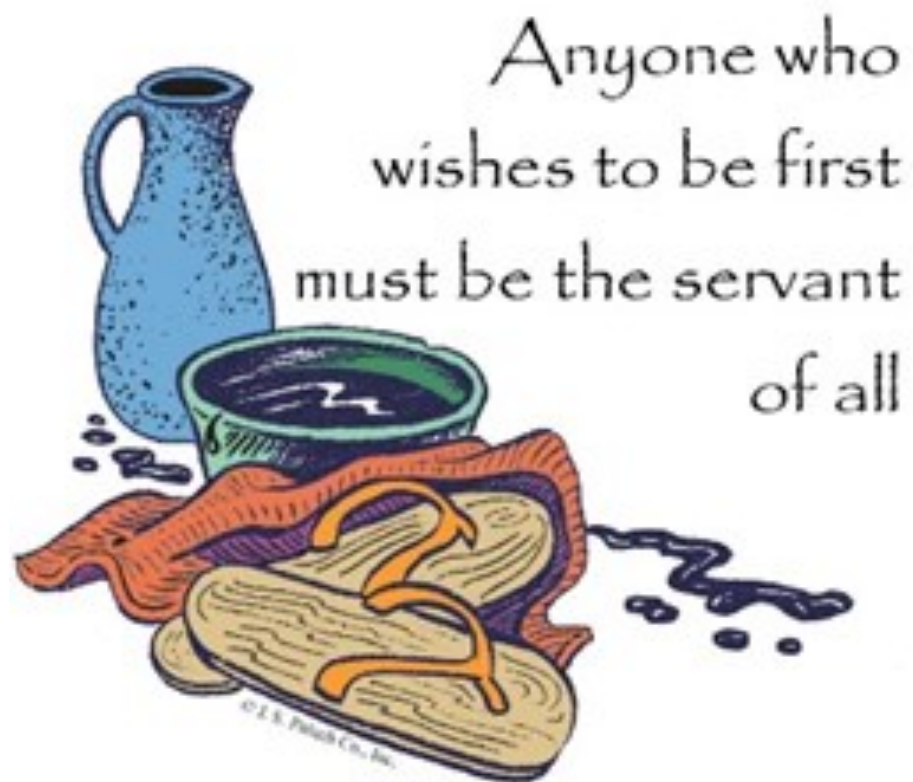

If you wish to smoke please go onto the **public pavement.**

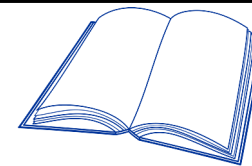

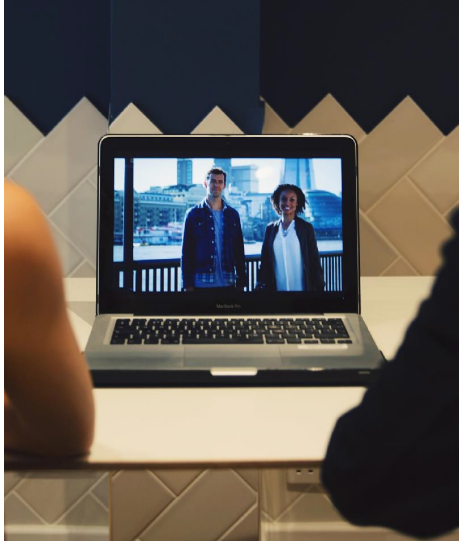
