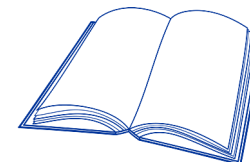

lunch in the parish room on

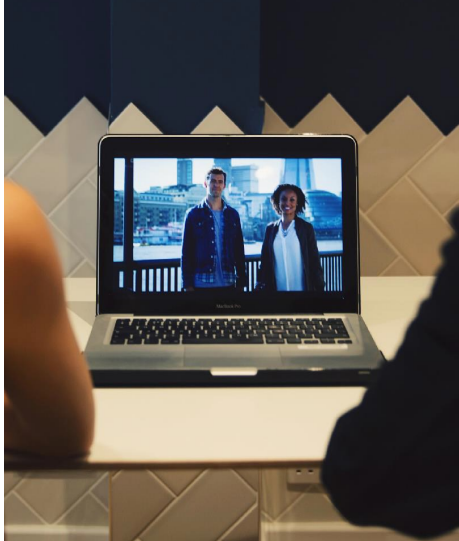
