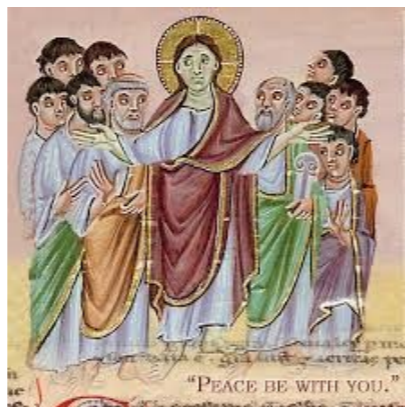

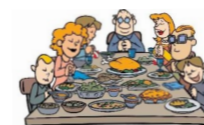
New members are very welcome.
