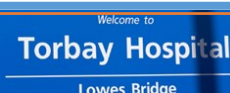


## Parish Rooms Hire Charges

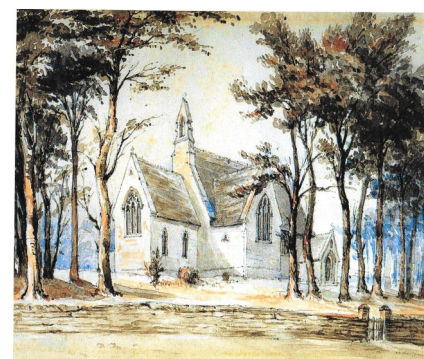
